The applicant has submitted a soil removal application with the District of Lake Country and currently has an application in with the Ministry of Mines.

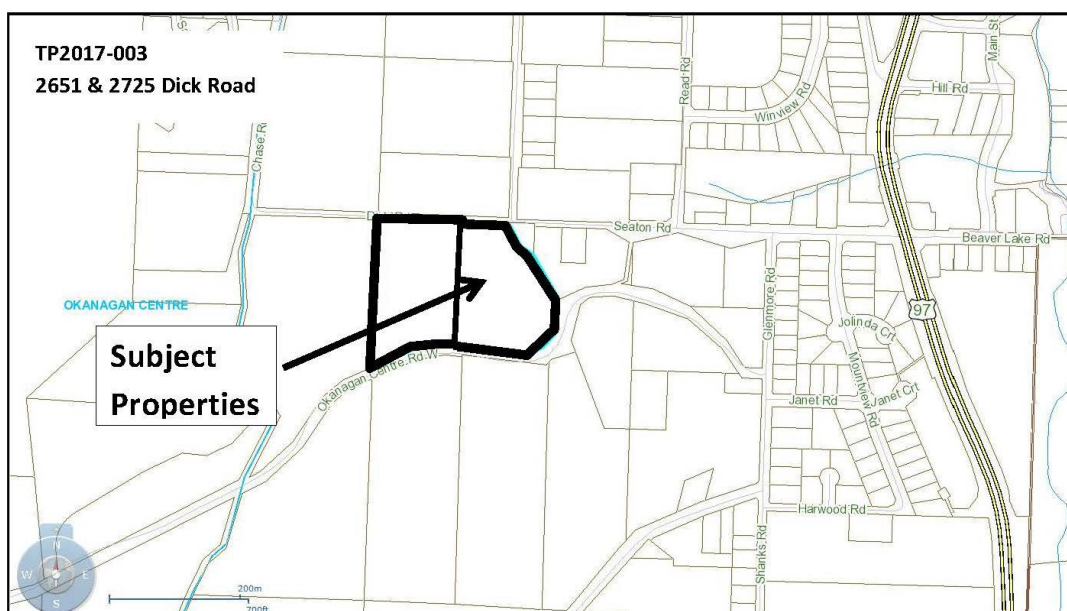
