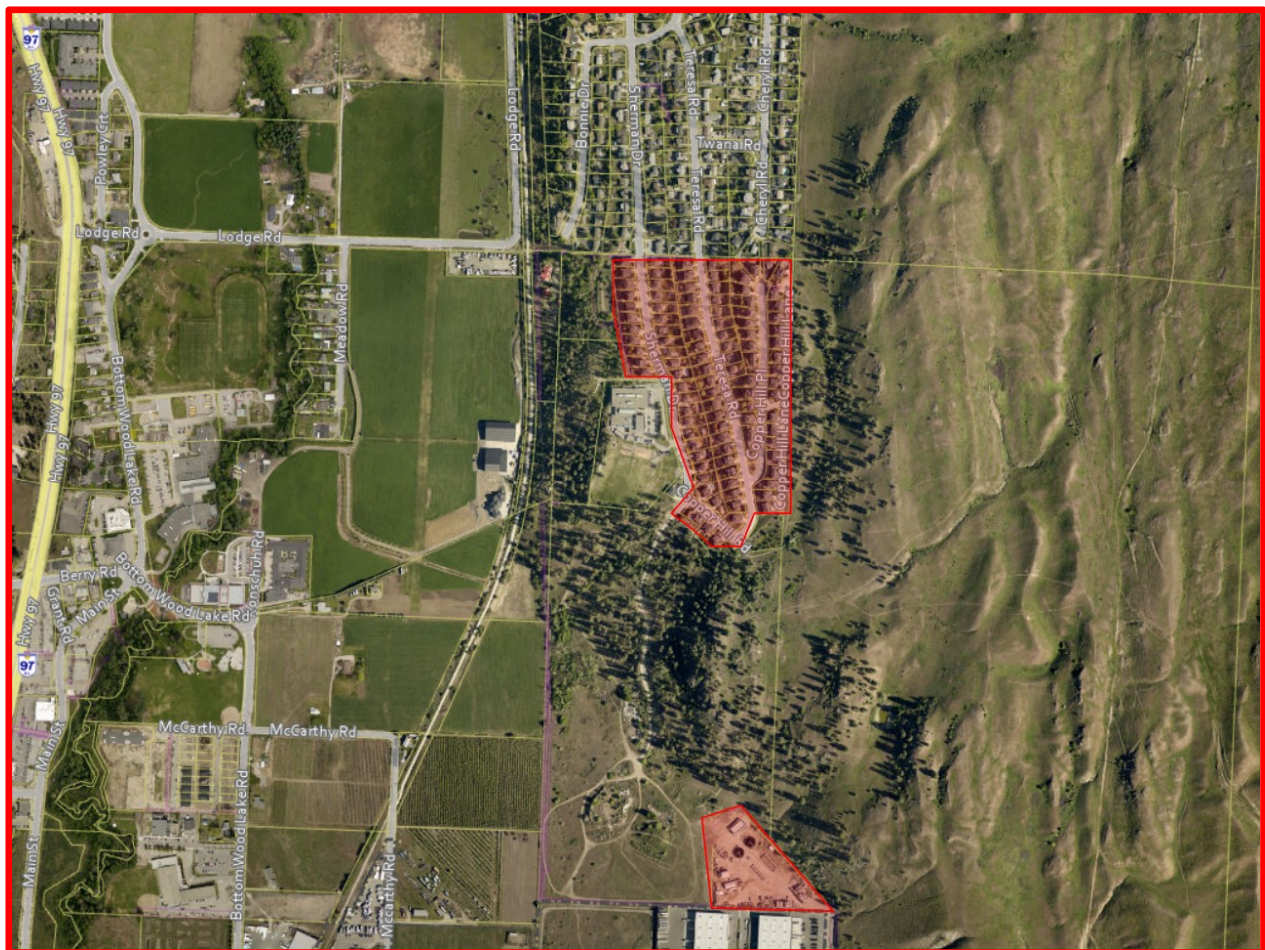


BOIL WATER NOTICE

June 11, 2025

The District of Lake country, in consultation with Interior Health, has issued a **BOIL WATER NOTICE (BWN)** starting **June 11th, 2025** for the affected properties outlined in the map below. The advisory is being issued in an abundance of caution due to the potential for low pressure during planned work on the water system. A map highlighting the affected customers in red is shown below.



The BWN is anticipated to last 6-7 days, and will be removed once testing confirms the water is safe to drink. Letters will be hand delivered when the water boil notice is rescinded. Additional information and live updates will also be posted on the District website, www.lakecountry.bc.ca.

The District of Lake Country and Interior Health recommend that **ALL** customers in the affected area drink boiled water or a safe alternative. Water intended for drinking, washing fruits and vegetables, making beverages or ice, or brushing teeth should be boiled for one minute. Boiled water should then be refrigerated in a clean, covered container. Customers could also choose to use bottled water or water that has been filtered through a well-maintained treatment device. A water fill station is available at the Winfield Arena, see image to the right.

The District also encourages residents to reduce non-essential water use to help prevent pressure loss.
