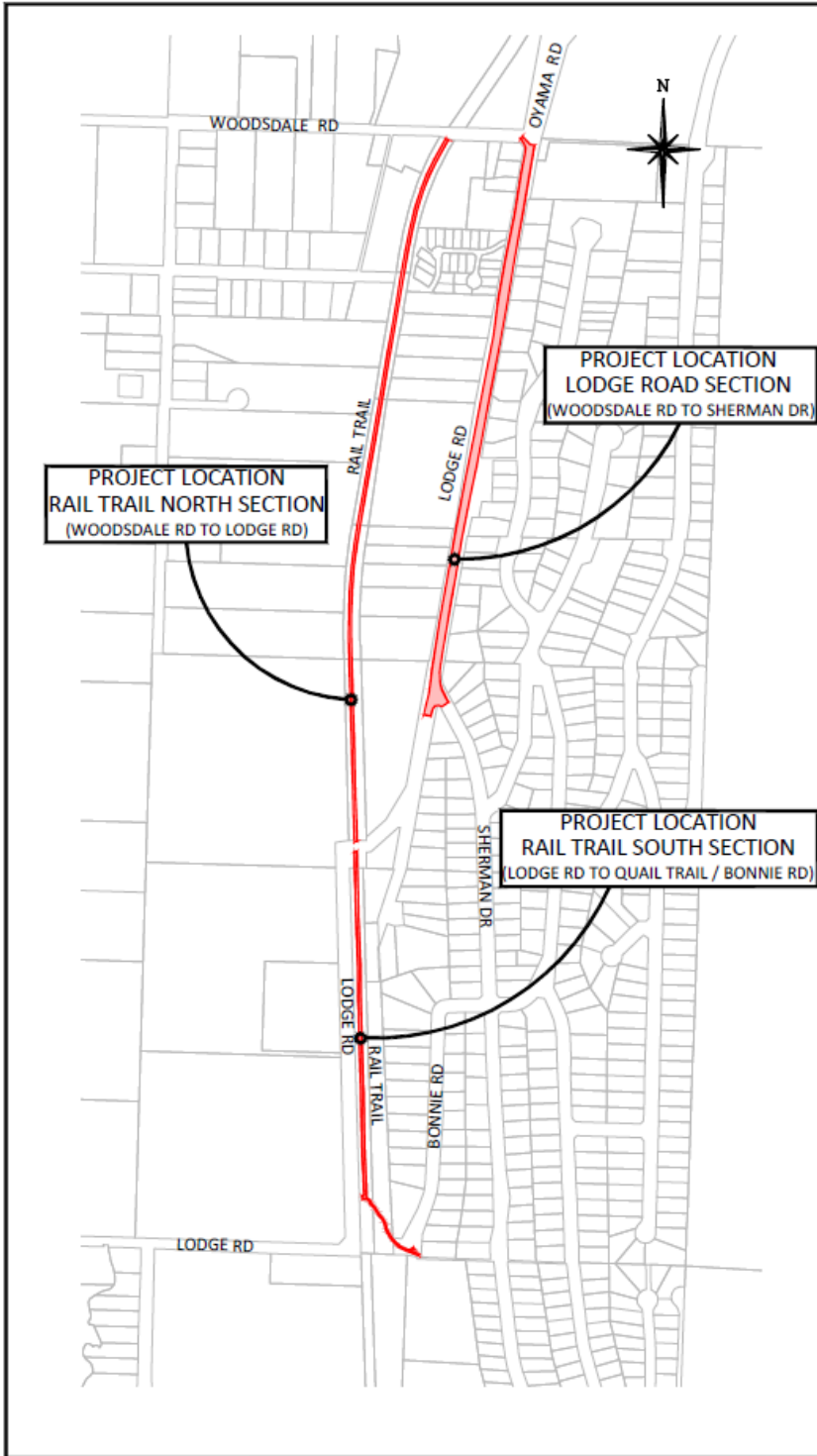
Infrastructure elements included in the construction project:

- **Lodge Road:**
 - Upgrade and replacement of drainage infrastructure,
 - Road structure and pavement renewal,
 - New sidewalks with curb and gutter for pedestrian safety,
 - Sherman Drive intersection realignment to enhance pedestrian visibility,
 - Transit stop improvements,
 - Pedestrian Activated beacons at crossings.
- **Rail Trail**
 - Paving of the rail trail from Woodsdale Road to existing walking trails from Clearwater development area and existing Lodge Road active transportation corridor.

FAQ

Will there be road closures and traffic control?

YES, Lodge Rd. will be closed to through traffic for the duration of the project. Local traffic will be accommodated, along with transit and school bus, Canada Post, waste collection vehicles and emergency vehicles. All can expect some delays. *Every effort will be made for urgent through access for emergency vehicles.* Detour and traffic control will be in place during closures.

What will road access be when the contractor is not working?

ONE- WAY TRAFFIC, at a minimum, will be maintained on Lodge Road, outside of contractor working hours, in a condition that the roadway can be reasonably travelled, even with low clearance cars.

I am a resident - what can I expect for my driveway access?

ACCESS WITH MINOR RESTRICTIONS, will be maintained and prior notice given to any disruptions to property access.

I am a rail trail user – will the trail be closed?

YES, during active construction for a short duration for grading and paving, prior to May 15. Detour and traffic control will be in place during closures.

If I have a concern who should I contact first?

THE CONTRACTOR should answer any initial inquires. Please see contractor information on the front side of this handout.
