

- 1 NON-COMBUSTIBLE CLADDING
- $\overline{2}$  FIRE RESISTENT ROOFING (CLASS A, B OR C RATED ROOFING MATERIALS)
- (3) TREES / SHRUBS (MIN. 10.0m FROM STRUCTURES) CONSIDER DECIDUOUS / LEAF TREES
- (4) NON-COMBUSTIBLE LANDSCAPING (MIN. 1.5m FROM STRUCTURES)
- (5) GUTTER GUARDS
- $\overbrace{6}$  ATTIC VENTING / INTAKE PENETRATIONS TO BE PROTECTED BY NON-COMBUSTIBLE 3mm SCREENS
- $\overline{7}$  ALL EXTERIOR DOORS TO BE WEATHERSTRIPPED (INCLUDES VEHICULAR DOORS)
- $\overline{(8)}$  KEEP DEBRIS FROM ACCUMULATING UNDER DECKS. ENCLOSE BELOW IF NOT ACCESSIBLE (LESS THAN 1.8m)
- 9 COMBUSTIBLE FENCING MIN. 1.5m FROM STRUCTURES
- (10) LANDSCAPING, FIRE RESISTENT PLANTINGS ONLY WITHIN 10.0m OF STRUCTURES FIRESMARTBC.CA/LANDSCAPING-HUB/FIRE-RESISTANT-PLANTS/
- (11) FIREWOOD PILES AND FUELS TO BE STORED MIN. 10.0m FROM STRUCTURES
- (12) FIRE PITS AND BURN BARRELS MIN. 3.0m FROM STRUCTURES
- (13) TREES, 10.0m FROM STRUCTURES TO BE SPACED MIN. 3.0m APART (CONSIDER DECIDUOUS / LEAF TREES)
- (14) BEST PRACTICE, KEEP PROPERTY MANICURED, PRUNED AND REMOVE COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS
- (15) FOLLOW BEST PRACTICE, SEE FIRE SMART CANADA NEIGHBOURHOOD RECOGNITION PROGRAM FIRESMARTBC.CA
