BYLAW 882

A BYLAW TO AMEND ZONING BYLAW 561, 2007

WHEREAS the Council of the District of Lake Country deems it appropriate to amend District of Lake Country Zoning Bylaw 561, 2007.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Lake Country, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1) Add, in alphabetical order, the following definition to Section 3.3. General Definitions:

ZIPLINE COURSE means a transportation system or piece of recreation equipment consisting of a cable stretched between points of different elevations, a pulley, and a harness or bar for attaching a rider, who moves by gravity. A zipline course may consist of a maximum of 10 individual cable segments; a maximum of 2 zipline courses may be developed on a property.

- 2) Add, in alphabetical order, "Zipline Course on Lot 2 Section 31 Township 21 ODYD Plan KAP84855" as a Secondary Use within Section 13.2. RLPO Rural Large Parcel Oyama Road.
- 2) This bylaw may be cited as "Zoning Amendment (Oyama Zipline) Bylaw 882, 2014".

READ A FIRST TIME this 4th day of February, 2014. READ A SECOND TIME this 3rd day of February, 2015.
